Item 5	Before age 16, how many times did an adult push, grab, shove or throw something at
	you to hurt you?
Item 6	Before age 16, how many times did an adult kick, bite, punch, choke, burn you, or
	physically attack you in some way?
Item 7	Before age 16, how many times did your parents, step-parents or guardians not take
	care of your basic needs, such as keeping you clean or providing food or clothing?
Item 8	Before age 16, how many times did an adult force you or attempt to force you into any
	unwanted sexual activity, by threatening you, holding you down or hurting you in
	some way?
Item 9	Before age 16, how many times did an adult touch you against your will in any sexual
	way? By this, I mean anything from unwanted touching or grabbing, to kissing or
	fondling.
Item 10	Before age 16, did you ever see or talk to the police or anyone from child protective
	services about any of the things you mentioned?
Item 11	Before age 16, how many times did you see or hear any one of your parents, step-
	parents or guardians say hurtful or mean things to each other or to another adult in
	your home?
Item 12	Did you ever experience the death or serious illness of a parent or a primary caretaker?
Item 13	Did you experience the divorce or separation of your parents?
Item 14	Did anyone in your family ever suffer from mental or psychiatric illness or have a
	"breakdown"?
