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Amendment to Nursing Act of 1991 and Regulation 275/94: December 2009

Bill 179 passed the Ontario Legislative Assembly on December 15, 2009. Among the changes in regulation was the ability of nurse practitioners in Ontario to “broadly prescribe drugs appropriate for client care” rather than prescribing from a list of approved medications (CNO, 2014). The ability to prescribe broadly went into effect and was implemented on October 1, 2011. The previous Schedules 2 and 3 were eliminated from the regulations.
