



Publication agreement for government employees

THIS AGREEMENT dated the ____ day of _____, 20____, is made between Joule Inc., a Canadian Medical Association company (the Publisher), incorporated under the laws of Canada, having its head office in Ottawa, Ontario,

In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

1. Grant of Rights

- 1.1 The Government grants to the Publisher a non-exclusive licence to print, reproduce, publish, transmit and distribute the Paper throughout the world, in any form and by any means, in print, electronically or otherwise, in any language, as part of the Journal. The Government expressly reserves copyright in the Paper.
- 1.2 The Government further grants to the Publisher the right to give and grant sublicences of any and all of the rights granted to the Publisher under this Agreement.
- 1.3 The duration of the rights granted under this Agreement shall be for the full term of copyright in the Paper, and any renewals of that copyright.

2. Government's Representations and Warranties

The Government represents and warrants to the Publisher:

- 2.1 that the Author(s) is/are (**check one**) the sole author(s) [or] a co-author(s) of the Paper, and that the Paper was researched and prepared on behalf of, and in the course of his/her/their employment with, the Government;
- 2.2 that the Government is (**check one**) the sole owner [or] a co-owner of copyright in the Paper;
- 2.3 that the Paper is an original work of authorship and does not plagiarize any other work or infringe any copyright, trademark or other proprietary right of any third party; and
- 2.4 that the Paper does not contain any libelous or unlawful matter and does not violate the privacy rights of any third party.

3. Publisher Covenants

- 3.1 The Publisher covenants that the source of the Paper, namely, the Author(s) and the Government, will be clearly indicated in the Journal and will use its best efforts to ensure that its sublicensees clearly indicate the source of the Paper.
